In April 2009, our core founder, Mrs. Leena Pawar was diagnosed with 'Acute Myeloid Leukaemia', a highly incurable type of blood cancer. During her several visits at the Tata Memorial Hospital Mumbai - India, the plight of patients and their families was heartbreaking. A lot of patients from lower socio-economic strata were struggling to meet their medicinal, boarding and other daily expenses. During her stay, she also noticed young children in the paediatric oncology missing out on crucial schooling. But, Mrs. Pawar was no ordinary patient. She chose not to wallow in self-pity over a bad hand dealt by life. In spite of her personal grievances that accompanied cancer treatment, she felt absolute compassion for those around her. She decided to help and support the needy by launching the NGO 'littleMORE'

littleMORE- An Indian Charitable Organization - Established and registered in the year 2009 as a non-profit Charitable Organization that strives endlessly for the welfare of underprivileged, without distinction of religion or caste.

Over the last decade we have been reaching out to the poor and marginalized patients and have acquired the faith and trust of many poor families that approach us for assistance.

Our aim is to lend constant support to the poor & needy of our society. We live by the motto of providing as much assistance as necessary to the patients who suffer from cancer / tuberculosis / diabetes / leprosy etc.

OUR ACTIVITIES:

Edutainment Program: 3 simultaneous programmes for paediatric and adult cancer patients and their care givers. Frequency: Twice a year

Gift Goodie Bag: Contains daily essentials like Tooth brush and paste / napkins, games, toys etc.

Frequency: Six times in a year

Health Awareness Programs: In educational institutes/corporate/housing complexes to dispel myths about cancer, diabetes, tuberculosis, Hepatitis B, Hepatitis C, Nutrition and diet and Dengue and Malaria, etc.

Frequency: 12 sessions in a year

Anaj Daan: Contains 15 kgs of rice, dal, wheat/jwar/bajra/ragi flour, oil, and sugar Frequency: Every 15th day of the month

Patient Awareness Sessions: Meeting for new patients and their care givers at Urology and Bone & Soft Tissue D.M.G. Frequency: Once a month

Goodie Bags Distribution: Contains daily essentials like Toothbrush and paste, napkins, soap, mat / umbrella, bed sheet, shirt piece, sari, lock & seal tiffin box, toys, plate, bowl, stationary folder, games, etc. Frequency: Twice a year

Joy of Giving: Corporates and home makers from housing complexes come together to collect & distribute goodies or gifts to the cancer patients.

Medicine Compliance: Assist doctors in identifying erroneous drug consumption by conducting daily screening of paediatric patients visiting the Hemato-Lymphoma (H.L.) OPD

Frequency: Six times in a week

Patient Navigation & Moral Support:

At Urology& Bone & Soft Tissue D.M.G. (Disease Management Group) during OPD days

Frequency: Twice a week (OPD days)

Nutritional Support to Tuberculosis patients: Create awareness about the disease, To help in ensuring early diagnosis and treatment, To provide Nutritional support & compassionate counseling

Financial Support: Seed money of Rs. 5000/-, scrutinized by littleMORE OPD volunteers & suggested by the hospital Medical Social Worker (M.S.W.) Frequency: Every month

Educational Sponsorship: Bright pediatric student(s) are scrutinized from the edutainment class, we support school fee for two years. Frequency: Every year

Edutainment Classes: Strengthening of subjects like English, Maths, EVS (Science & Social Studies) based on the NCERT 5th grade curriculum along with Arts & crafts

Frequency: Every Saturday from Novemberto March


